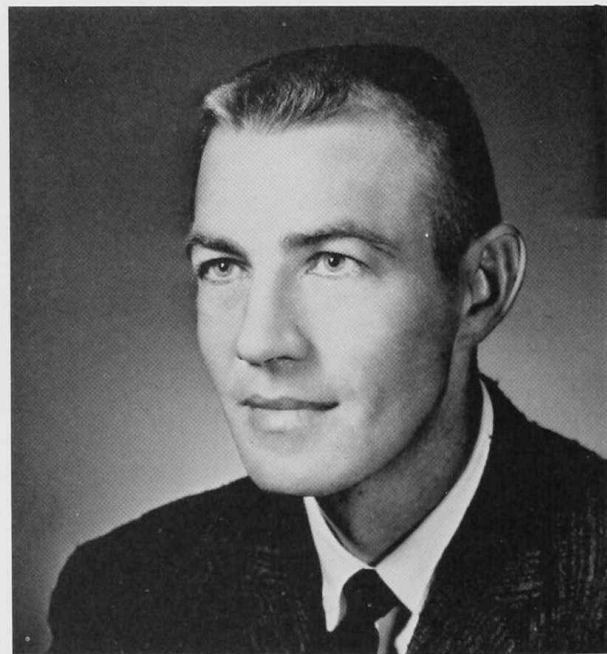

As the graduating Seniors look through the yearbook may they remember the doors that have been opened to them by experience and guidance at Springfield High School.

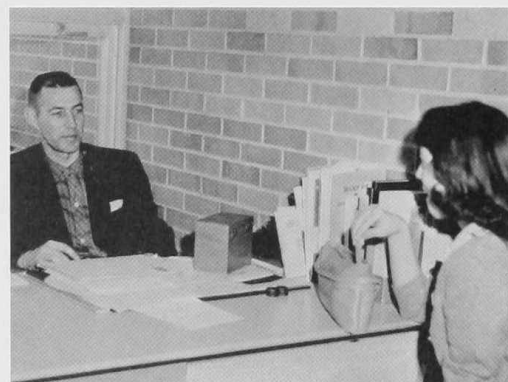
