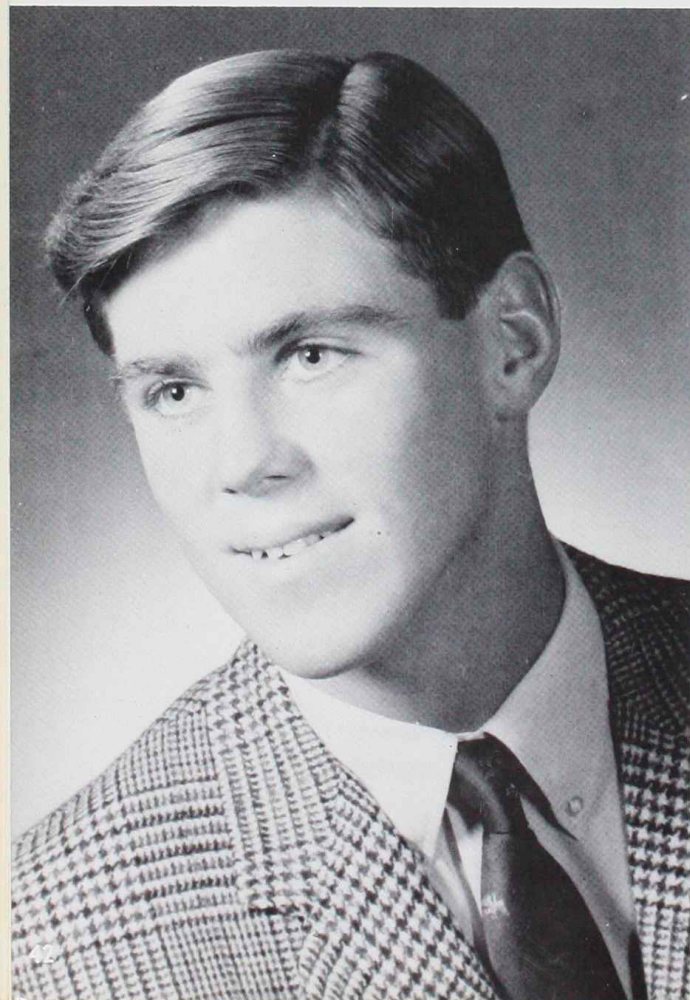
SUMMARY
