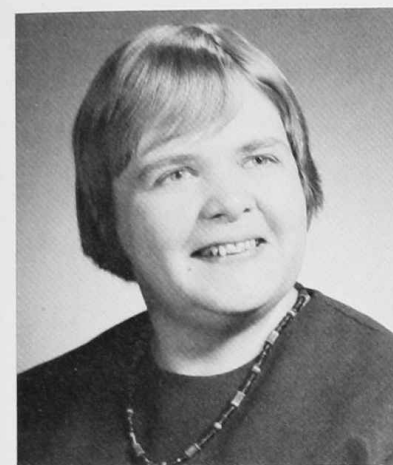

MATH: Math classes strive to stimulate minds and prepare a person for the future in such areas as bookkeeping, record-keeping, algebra, and general math.

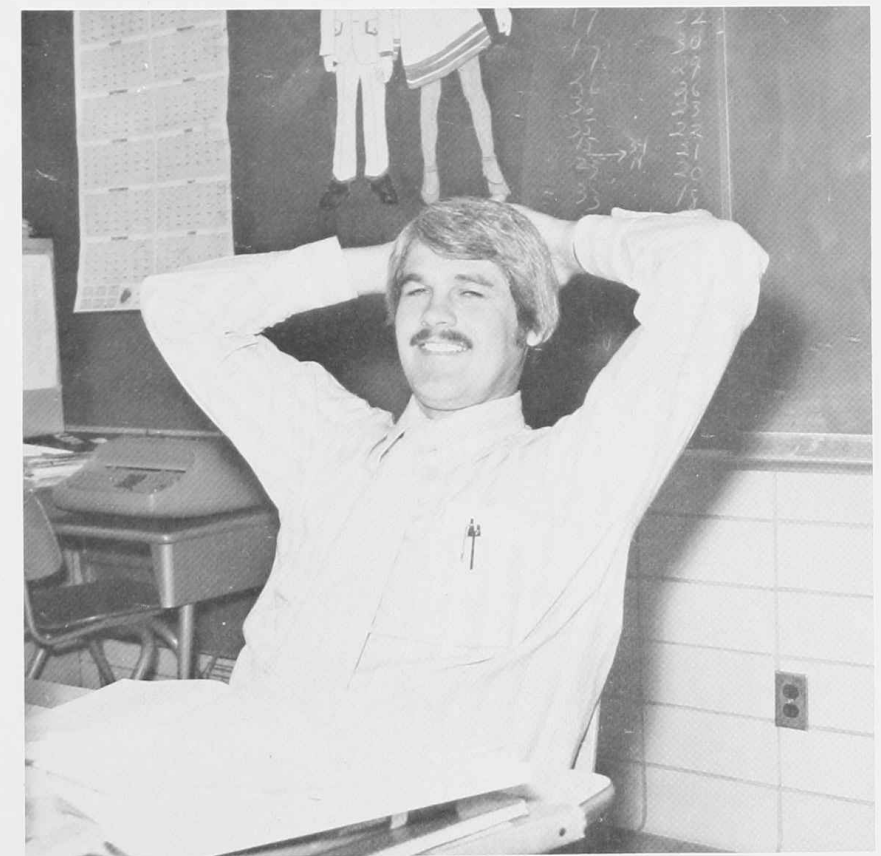

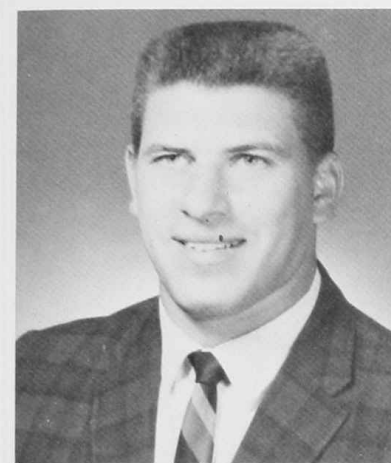
## Band and Choir
