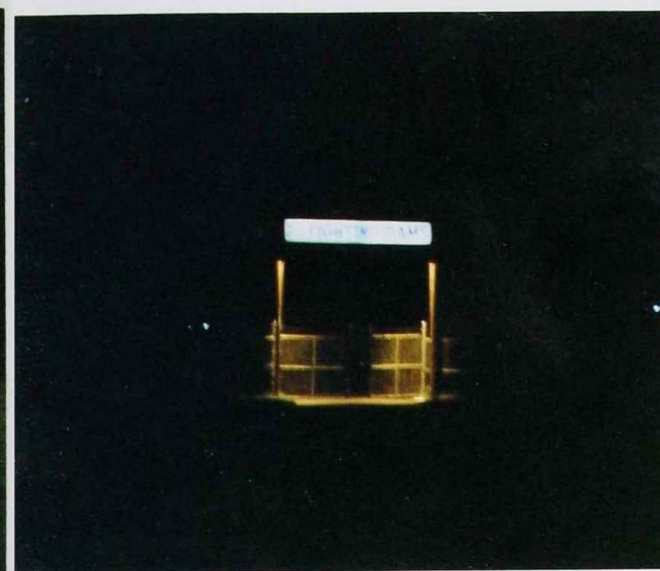
The Spirit of Springfield.

Co-op Students Earn Credits and Money

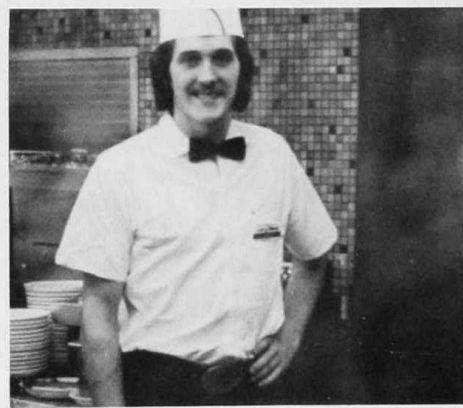

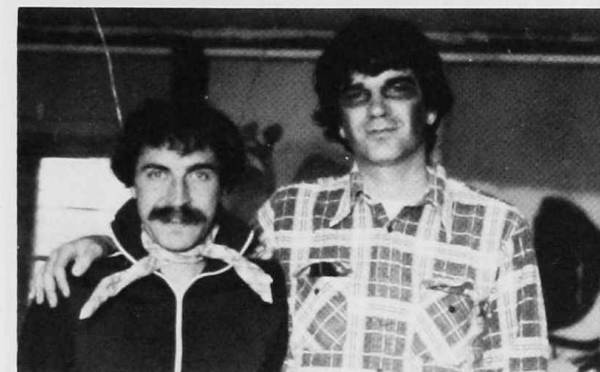
Communication Students Go to Tuwaqachi

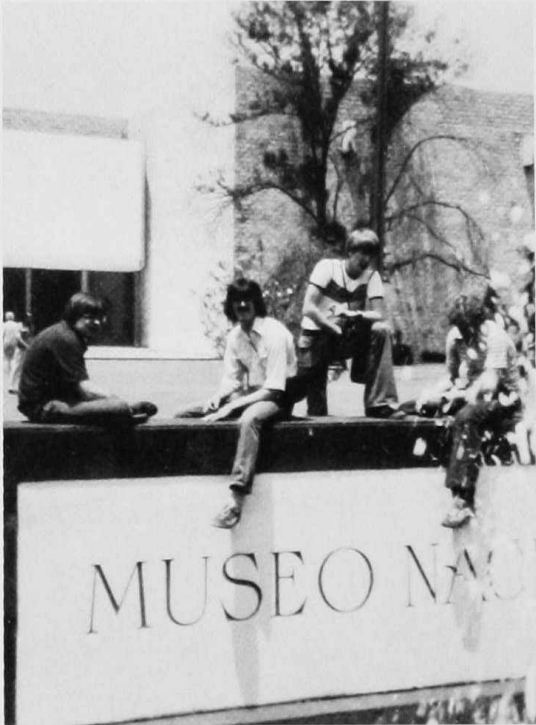
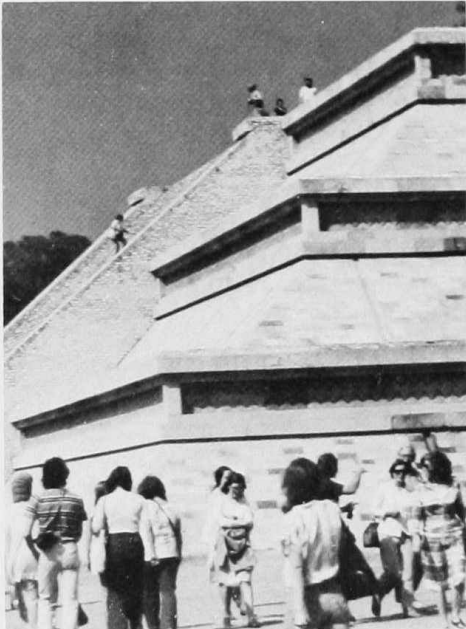

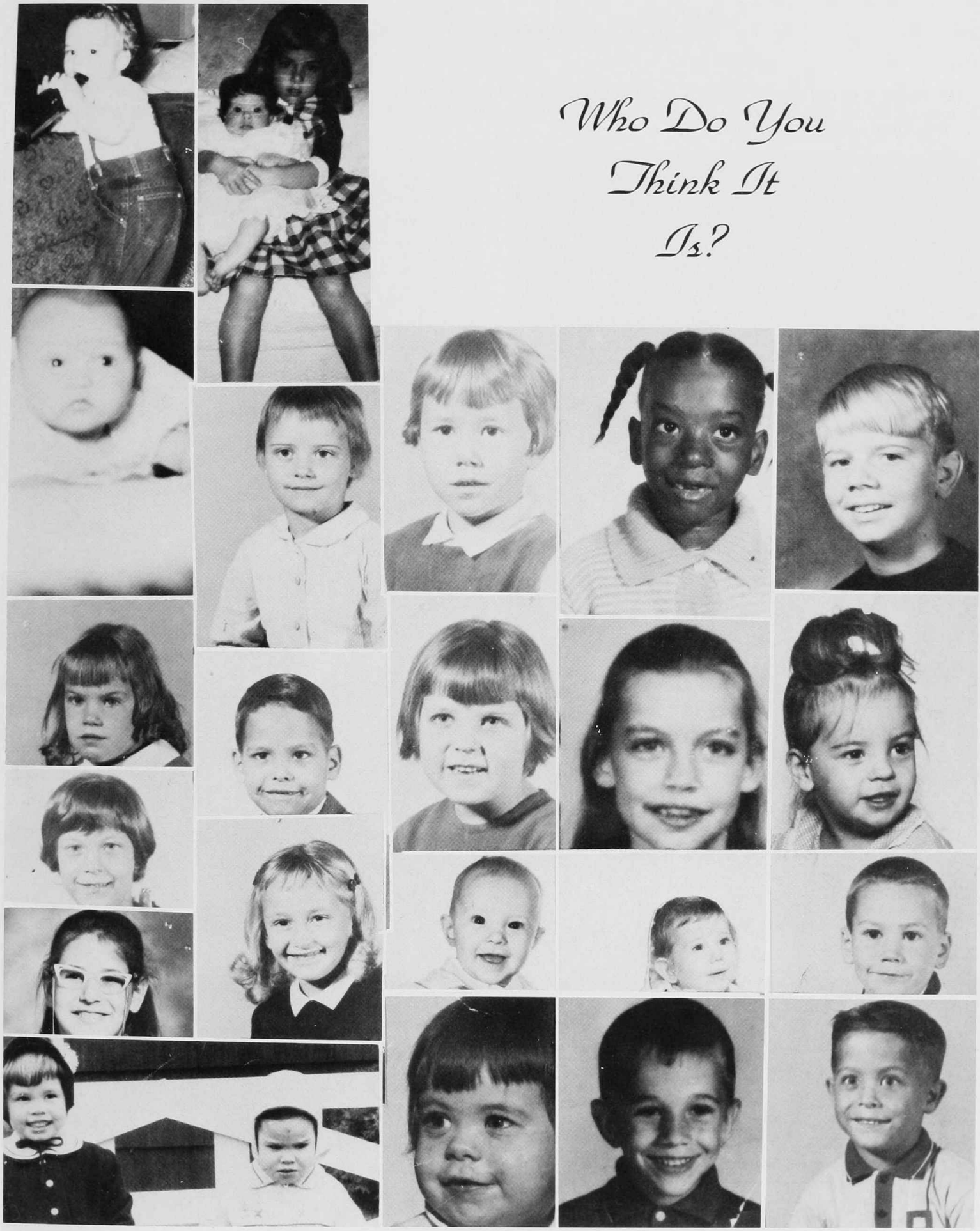


Movin' on to Mexico

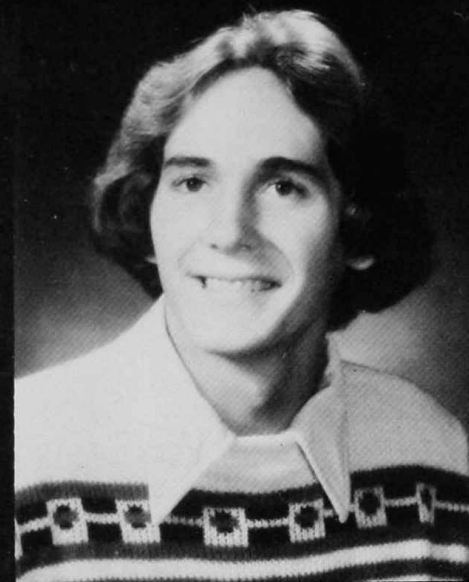
National Honor Society
